SMALL GROUP GUIDE

Matthew 1:20-23; Luke 1:30-35; John 1:1-14; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4; Philippians 2:5-11; Colossians 1:13-23; Hebrews 1:1-14; 7:21-25; 1 John 5:20; Revelation 1:4-8

PRAY

READ JOHN 14:6

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

DISCUSS

1. Read John 1:14-17 & Hebrews 1:1-3.
 - a. Explain how Jesus is our Prophet.
2. Read Psalm 110, Hebrews 7:15-28; Hebrews 10:19-22.
 - a. Explain how Jesus is our Priest.
3. Read Isaiah 9:6-7; 11:1-5; Matthew 28:18-20.
 - a. Explain how Jesus reigns as our King.

APPLY

2. How are you embracing His forgiveness as our Priest?

FAMILY GUIDE
