## WEEK 4 | JESUS THE SON

### SERMON NOTES

*"I and the Father are one." (John 10:30)*

*"What do you think about the Christ? Whose son is he?" They said to him, "The son of David." He said to them, "How is it then that David, in the Spirit, calls him Lord, saying, 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet"'? If then David calls him Lord, how is he his son?" And no one was able to answer him a word, nor from that day did anyone dare to ask him any more questions." (Matthew 22:42-44)*

"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."  
(John 14:6)

A complete understanding of Jesus and the gospel changes your response to everything else.

Jesus was the fulfillment of all things promised by God.

#### Jesus Is a Prophet - He Mediates the Message from God

The role of a prophet was to speak the word of God.

*In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe (Hebrews 1:1-2).*

#### Jesus Is a Priest - He Mediates the Approach to God

Priests were mediators between God and man.

#### Jesus Is King - He Mediates the Rule of God

A king is one who has complete authority over another.

#### Jesus Christ our Messiah - Mediator in His Three Messianic Offices

Mediator - 1 Timothy 2:5-6

Christ (Greek) = Messiah (Hebrew)

Prophet - Greater than Moses - Mediates the Word of God, so we can know God. (John 1:14-17; Hebrews 1:1-3)

- God wants a relationship with us and took the initiative to make Himself known.
- God shares His character, glory, wisdom, and love towards us.
- God is fully made known in Christ, the prophet who is God in the flesh.

Priest - Greater than Aaron - Mediates the Access to God so we can approach God. (Psalms 110:4; Hebrews 10:19-22)

- After man's sin, the way to God has to be through sacrifice.
- When Jesus died, the veil torn showed a new way to God was now opened.
- By faith in Christ alone, we now come into the presence of God.

King - Greater than Solomon - Mediates the Rule of God so we can be governed by God. (Isaiah 9:6-7; 11:1-5; Matthew 28:18)

- God's desires to restore us to His kingdom.
- Christ is our rightful King and alone is worthy to rule our lives.
- Jesus taught us to pray "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven."
