SMALL GROUP GUIDE

Gen 1:26-28; Psalm 8:3-5; Psalm 139:13-16; Gen 3:8; 1 Corinthians 1:9; 1 John 1:3;

PRAY

Father, thank You for creating humanity in Your image, to have fellowship with You, with purpose, and value. Teach us to see ourselves and others through your eyes — with humility, honor, and grace. Shape us to live as image bearers who glorify you in the way we abide, serve, and share you with others.

READ GENESIS 1:26-28

Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the seas and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. And God blessed them. And God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth." (Genesis 1:26-28)

DISCUSS

2. What does it look like practically to reflect God's character in stewarding His creation well?
3. In what ways do people commonly try to find identity apart from God?
4. How does the gospel restore and reshape our understanding of humanity and purpose?

APPLY

1. What is one practical way you can reflect God's character this week—through integrity, mercy, humility, creativity, or love—in your interactions with others this week?
2. What rhythms are you currently practicing that are strengthening or weakening your relationship with God?
3. How are you stewarding all that God has entrusted to you?
