### SERMON NOTES

#### 4 Views of Creation:

- Secular Evolution (Big Bang Theory): No god is responsible for creation.
- Theistic Evolution: God set evolution into motion.
- Day Age: Each day of creation is an extensive time period.
- Six-Day Creationism: A day is a day (Genesis 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31).

#### 4 Reasons for Creationism:

1. The Sabbath law is literally established on a creation week (Exodus 20:8-11).
2. Adam is spoken of by Paul and biblical genealogies (Romans 5:14, 2 Corinthians 15:22, 1 Timothy 2:13, Genesis 5:3-5, Luke 3:38).
3. Scripture teaches worship of God as Creator (Psalms 139:13-14, Colossians 1:15-17, Revelation 4:9-11).
4. The flood gives explanation.

“Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. And God blessed them. And God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth.” (Genesis 1:26-28)

2. As Male and Female (1:27)

#### Why were we created?

1. To have fellowship with God.
2. To have dominion, authority, over God's creation (1:26). To steward God's creation well.
3. To be fruitful and multiply (1:28).
4. To Give God Glory

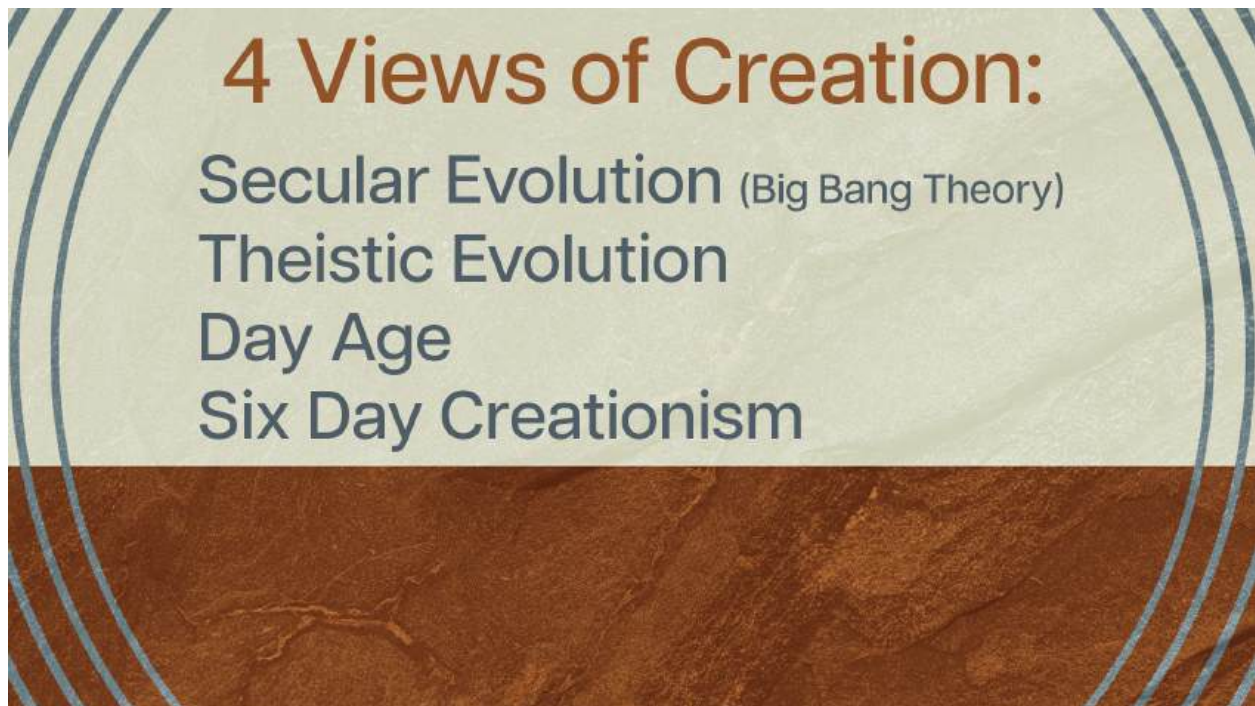
Without fellowship with God, there is no fulfillment.
