### SMALL GROUP GUIDE

*Colossians 1:16-17; Psalm 148:2; Isaiah 6:1-3; Psalm 103:20-21; 1 Peter 1:12; Luke 15:10; Hebrews 1:7,14*

### PRAY

*Heavenly Father, thank You for revealing Your glory, power, and purposes through Your angels. Help us to worship you with greater awe, obey you with greater faithfulness, and trust your care in every circumstance. May our lives, like angels, point others to Jesus alone, in whose name we pray, Amen.*

### READ COLOSSIANS 1:16-17

*For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things and in him all things hold together. (Colossians 1:16-17)*

### DISCUSS

1. What are some common misconceptions people have about angels, and how does Scripture correct them?
2. What do the angels' continual worship in Isaiah 6 teach us about God's holiness and worthiness?
3. Why do you think angels rejoice over one sinner who repents (Luke 15:10)?
4. What stands out to you about the angels' immediate obedience to God's commands (Psalm 103:20-21)? What is one area of your life where God's will is clear, but obedience remains difficult?
5. How does the angel's role as messengers challenge us to faithfully share the Gospel today?

### APPLY

1. What is one attribute of the angels that you most need to imitate right now: worship, obedience, humility, service, or sharing the Gospel?
2. How can you intentionally begin/continue to grow in that area this week?
3. What specific step will you take this week to point others toward Christ rather than yourself?
