SMALL GROUP GUIDE

Isaiah 9:6-7; Daniel 2; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Corinthians 15:51-58; Matthew 25:31-46; Titus 2:11-14; John 14:29

PRAY

Father, thank You for revealing Yourself through Your Word and for always keeping Your promises. As we open Scripture, help us not only to understand prophecy but also to know you more deeply and to live obediently in light of Jesus' certain return. Fill us with hope, confidence, and purpose to make disciples until He comes again. May our study lead to eager expectation. In Jesus' name, Amen.

READ TITUS 2:13-14

Waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works. (Titus 2:13-14)

DISCUSS

1. What do these passages reveal about God's faithfulness to keep His promises? Where do you see evidence of that in the text?
2. According to 1 Thess. 4:13-18; John 14:29; Titus 2:11-14, why did God give prophecy? What response does He desire from His people?
3. What attitudes and actions does Scripture call believers to have as we wait for Jesus' return? List the commands or characteristics you find in the passages.
4. As you reflect on Christ's promised return, what stirs your heart most—hope, urgency, joy, uncertainty, worship, or something else? Why?

APPLY

1. What is one way you can live with greater hope and confidence this week because Jesus is coming again?
2. What is one area where you need to replace fear or distraction with confidence in Christ?
3. Who is one person you can intentionally serve or share the hope of Jesus with this week as you live in light of His return?

FAMILY GUIDE

CORE TRUTH:

Because prophecy guarantees the return of Jesus, we can live today with an eternal perspective and an unshakable hope.

READ

*And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new."
(Revelation 21:5)*

QUESTIONS

2. What may be distracting you from focusing on an eternal perspective? How can you surrender or remove those distractions as a family?
3. How does this hope encourage you to share God's Good News of restoration with others?
